EMBEDDING VIDEO ON WEBSITES



HOW CAN YOU EMBED A VIDEO ON YOUR WEBSITE?

When your video has been finished and is uploaded to the Take One YouTube channel, you can embed the video onto your website directly from the channel.

- Open your web browser and go to <http://www.youtube.com/user/TakeOneTVUK>.
- Find your video in our channel playlist. Use the search function on the top-right of the channel if you can't find it easily.
- Click on the video and it will take you to the view page where the video will play automatically.
- Click on the **Share** button underneath the video, and then click on the **Embed** button to show the video embedding options.
- **Untick** the 'Show suggested videos when the video finishes' option – this will prevent YouTube from automatically displaying links to other videos when your one finishes.
- Select the size you want the embedded video to be.
- Finally, copy the generated code above the various options, and paste it into the HTML code of your website.
